#### **DESCRIPTION**

This course focuses on the theories and principles of Course Design and Materials Development for ELT. The course explores materials selection, adaptation, development and evaluation as ongoing processes in teacher preparation and development. The course provides an in-depth review of the many factors affecting professional materials and course development, including methodology, teacher belief system, students' proficiency levels, learning styles, modes of interactions, etc. The purpose of the course is to develop design and evaluation criteria for materials design and the ability to relate materials design to Language Teaching practices. This is to enable teachers to write the pedagogical intervention of their M.A. dissertations, as well as to design the accompanying supporting documents (lesson plans, course syllabus, pedagogical platform, etc.)

#### **COURSE GOALS**

- 1. To support the students' processes of materials evaluation, adaptation and/or development.
- 2. To help students identify underlying beliefs about the learning process, language and pedagogy.
- 3. To assist students in writing the pedagogical intervention/instructional design of their theses.
